„Kunst trifft Kohl 2011“ (Art in the allotment gardens 2011)

The exhibition "Kunst trifft Kohl" (art meets cabbage) is taking place for the 7th time already in Münster and this year it will, for the first time, exceed the town frontiers. Besides the known exhibition areas in the allotment garden sites "Am Münsterblick", "Bergbusch" and "Am Heidegrund" you will be able to admire works on the grounds of the golf club as well Wilkinghege. Additionally, the sandstone museum Havixbeck and the circular educational garden Steinfurt (Kreislehrgarten) are co-operating this year in this exceptional cultural project in Nordrhein-Westfalen. The curators Roland Seim and Annette Georgi are pleased by the increasing number of interested people. During the time of the project "Kunst trifft Kohl" the allotment garden sites will be transformed for one summer into a temporary sculpture park. Especially the contrasts make this project so successful. This project enables people with different interests and conceptions of life to meet and the allotment gardeners can prove once more that they are not only interested in gardens, greenery and cabbage but are open for art as well.
