Being present – Informing the citizens

The German allotment gardeners attended the Open Door Day in the Ministry of Transport on 4th September 2012.

This year for the first time, the allotment gardeners presented a project during the open door days of the federal government. The latter was an attraction point for the public. Nice prices could, moreover, be won in a quiz (Baum–Schlau-Quiz).

The information stand was initiated and organised by the division SW 11 of the transport ministry. Both young and old showed a great interest for this project. More than 1.600 Berlin citizens visited our stand on both days. During his visit the Parliamentary State Secretary Dr. Andreas Scheuer had encouraging words for the efforts of the allotment gardeners.
