The BKD Federal Centre - officially opened!

On 27.08.2024, the Bundesverband der Kleingartenvereine Deutschlands e. V. (BKD), umbrella organisation of around 900,000 allotment gardeners in Germany, opened its new federal centre with the permanent exhibition "City | Nature | People" with invited guests from the allotment garden movement, the local authorities, science and European partner organisations from 9 countries.

At the interface of neighbourhood and green lung - in the middle of Berlin Neukölln - an open house has been created that can also be used by other "green actors" for a variety of events and

will give the interests of allotment gardens with their social, ecological and cultural achievements greater voice in political Berlin. The new federal centre is also an exhibition centre on the future of allotment gardens, an education and seminar centre as well as a conference and event venue. It is also the office of the German federation of allotment garden associations and the German allotment garden youth organisation.

Opening ceremony for the Federal Centre

BKD Association President Dirk Sielmann welcomed over 150 guests to the grand evening ceremony. He thanked the Federal Ministry of Housing, Urban Development and Building (BMWSB) for funding the Federal Centre on the basis of a resolution passed by the German Bundestag, which made the building with its environmentally friendly timber construction possible in the first place.

Support came from the Federal Ministry of Housing, Urban Development and Building: The Federal Minister for Building, Klara Geywitz, emphasised the indispensable contribution that allotment gardens make to urban and rural life, to the urban climate, to biodiversity and to social integration. She emphasised once again that the federal allotment garden law has proved its worth from the point of view of the federal ministry and should remain unchanged in its current form: "This law protects the allotment gardens in the Federal Republic of Germany and it will remain as it is." Her ministry had funded 90 per cent of the project in Hermannstraße, which was built using sustainable timber construction methods. The deputy district mayor of Neukölln, Gerrit Kringel, also welcomed the new neighbour BKD and the guests to his district and emphasised that they were proud to have such an important association within walking distance of Neukölln town hall: "You have chosen the right location. Allotment gardens are indispensable."

In future, people of all ages will be able to visit the exhibition in groups or individually, experience the exhibits with all their senses, e.g. smell the asphalt of the city, but also feel the warmth in the compost heap or hear the sounds of earthworms in the soil.
